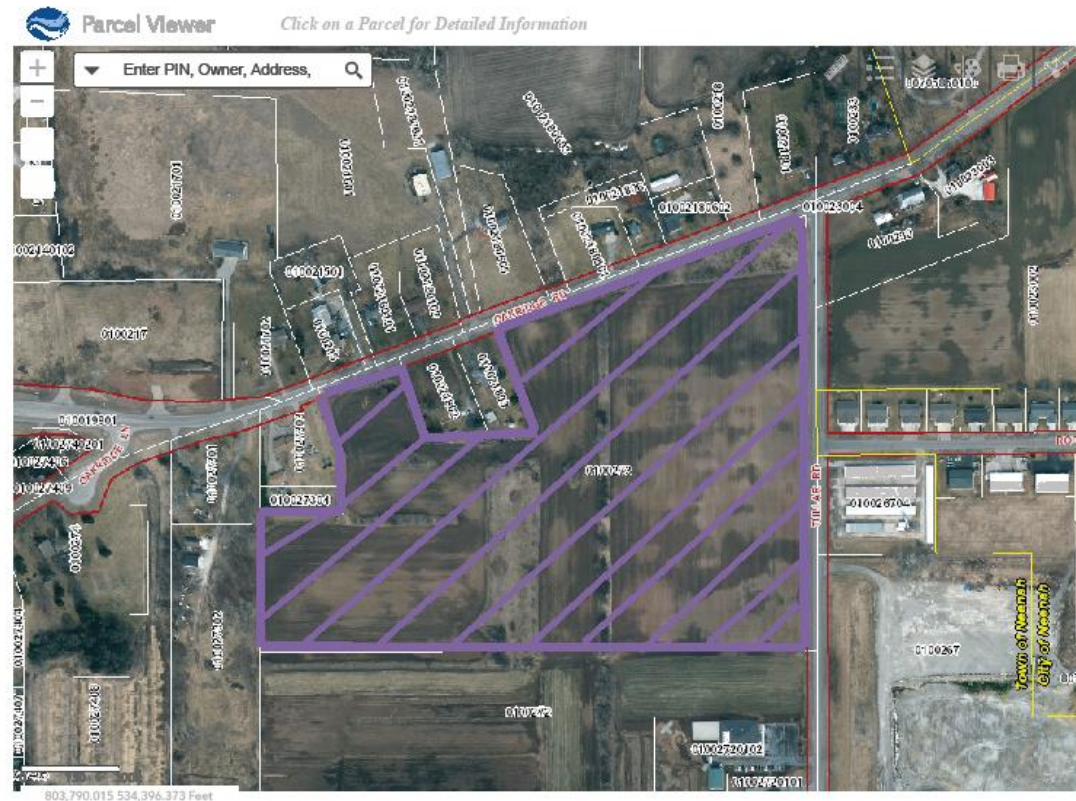

Sale of Property



- ▶ Located at south west corner of Tullar Road and Oakridge Road
- ▶ Sold in April 2020, proceeds = \$732,045

CTH “O” Pond



- ▶ Substantially Completed
- ▶ Cost = \$1,098,081

Franzoi Park Shelter



- ▶ Substantially Complete – Cost \$274,438
- ▶ Includes half court basketball court, cost covered by a \$35,000 donation from a Town of Neenah resident. The painting of the court and installation of basketball hoop to be completed this summer

Road Construction

- ▶ In 2019 – Completed Courtney Court – Complete reconstruction with new water, sanitary and storm water infrastructure in partnership with City of Neenah
- ▶ in 2020
 - ▶ Completed Chip Seal on six roads
 - ▶ Resurfaced Fieldcrest Drive
 - ▶ Resurfaced Mandella Court
- ▶ Partnered with Sanitary District #2 and City of Neenah with their project to resurface a section of Breezewood Lane from Pendleton Drive to the Town Hall.

New Crew Cab Pick-up for Fire Department



- ▶ Received over \$24,000 in donations towards the purchase of this vehicle.
- ▶ Town of Neenah Fires Department funds raised over last several years will cover the remaining cost of the vehicle

Municipal Court

- ▶ In the process of joining the Village of Winneconne Municipal Court
- ▶ Town Board has the authority to issue citations to enforce Town of Neenah Ordinances



Sanitary District #2

- ▶ Completed a joint project with City of Neenah to construct a collector pipe from Cumings Lane to Breezewood Lane. Took Lift Station #7 out of service.
- ▶ Completed improvement to Lift Station #2 on Rainbow Beach Road to the house the generator and provide storage for Sanitary District #2 equipment.

Annexation of Town Property



- Town of Neenah lost 225 acres of property through annexation to the Village of Fox Crossing.
