Adopt-A-Park / Trail Program

What is the Adopt-A-Park / Trail Program?

The Town of Neenah has developed an Adopt-A-Park / Trail Program for volunteers to contribute to park / trail beautification, providing minor ongoing maintenance, enhancing the park / trail experience, and assisting in monitoring these resources in the Town of Neenah.

Who Can Adopt a Park or Trail?

Anyone with an interest in the outdoors is welcome to participate. Individuals, families, businesses, community and service organizations, churches, schools, and scout troops are all examples of volunteers. Individuals under 16 years of age, however, must be accompanied by an adult. The Town of Neenah cannot assume responsibility for the safety or health conditions of persons participating in volunteer service work. The Park and Trail committee reserve the right to accept or decline all requests for participation in the program.

Why Should You Participate?

Adopting a park or trail section provides you with an opportunity to be actively involved in conservation and preservation. Helping to maintain and enhance the park or trail improves the resource for all to enjoy. The effort brings individuals and nature enthusiasts closer to the environment and their community. Volunteers will enjoy the time they spend outdoors and the personal satisfaction gained through volunteerism. Corporations and businesses have the opportunity to be recognized for their support of the town and supporting natural healthy lifestyles in our community.

What Do Volunteers Do?

Adopt-A-Park / Trail volunteers assist maintenance staff in maintaining the park / trail system but will not be asked to perform tasks they are uncomfortable doing. Activities include:

- Keeping the park / trail surface free of sticks, rocks, and other debris
- Pruning small limbs from the trail corridor, paths, or spectator areas
- Cleaning debris from trails and trailhead
- Litter clean-up; Cleaning water bars and drainage ditches
- Reporting erosion problems, suspicious or illegal activities, vandalism, and safety issues
- Provide memorial or monetary gifts for ongoing beautification and improvements

Adopt-A-Park / Trail Guidelines:

A trail section or park must be adopted for a period of one (1) year, renewable annually upon approval of the TNPTC. This agreement may be terminated at any time without notice by the Town of Neenah.

Volunteers are asked to maintain the adopted trail section or park as needed, but a minimum of 4 times a year. You choose the days and times you would like to work your trail or park. After each visit, send a written summary to the TNPTC for recognition and so that we can keep track of your efforts. The TNPTC will provide volunteers with guidelines on maintaining their trail or park area. Volunteers are asked to provide their own tools. Volunteers should dress appropriately for trail work, which includes gloves, safety glasses, and other protective gear. All work must be performed during daylight hours and with safety in mind. Work must be previously agreed upon by a TNPTC committee member.

How Do I Get Started?

Let us know if you have a particular park area or trail section in mind, and we will check to see if it is available. We can set you up right away. You need only to agree with the guidelines and sign an agreement form.
