Chairman R Schmeichel called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

• E. Skerke reviewed the first quarter 20201 Treasurer's report.

Accept resignation of Fire Fighter Briar Hass effective April 12, 2021.

• E. King reported that Briar Hass submitted his letter of resignation, there are some pieces of apparel that need to be returned which he will follow up on.

**Motion:** B. Cardoza / J. Weiss to accept resignation of Briar Hass effective April 12, 2021. Motion Carried 5:0:0.

R. Schmeichel thanked the E. King for inviting the Town Board to the Fire Fighter training on Saturday April 10th. He asked E. King to sign a joint Thank you letter to Dan and Nancy Brown thanking them for providing the department the opportunity.

#### Oakridge Road / Larsen Road

Accept McMahon Agreement for Topographic Survey Services Larsen Road and Oakridge Road, total cost is \$18,412.

**Motion:** G. Armstrong / J. Weiss to approve Resolution 2021-06 for the Conditional Use Permit Request.

- B. Hamblin reviewed the agreement and the three separate line items including Larsen Rd west
  of CTH CB, Oakridge Rd east of CTH CB and the City of Neenah portion from the maintenance
  line east to Green Bay Rd. AS with previous arrangements, the Town will manage the project
  and invoice the City for their portion.
- This agreement is for topographic survey work, the next step in the design process would be the actual design work.
- Discussion regarding Neenah Joint School District responsibility and Village of Fox Crossing responsibility.
- G. Armstrong reported the roads have paser rating of 5.
- R. Schmeichel stated this would be a three-to-five-year project, this is only the first step to start the design process and get the plans to a shovel ready project status.
- G. Armstrong questioned where the funds to pay for the agreement will come from, what budget line item and could any be charged to stormwater.
- B. Hamblin stated that stormwater is a part of the project, he will have to look at the percentage that would be reasonable to charge to stormwater.
- R. Schmeichel stated that the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds may be eligible for some
  of the costs if associated to a sewer project.
- Discussion about Village of Fox Crossing and their responsibility to participate as they own half of the road of the annexed school district property.
- E. Skerke to follow up with the Village to find out what topographic work may have already been completed by the School District as part of the new high school project. B. Hamblin to follow up on what portion would be cost share with the Village.
- B. Hamblin stated this is a large project and would take several months to design, the goal is to have a design ready for a project to be completed in 2023 or later.
- R. Schmeichel / B. Cardoza rescinded their motion pending further information. E. Skerke and B. Hamblin to provide additional information related to the percent charged to stormwater, the village / school district portion, and a budget amendment to account for these costs.

#### Resolution - CTH CB / CTH JJ Roundabout

Approve Resolution 2021-07 In Support of Pedestrian Rapid Flashing Beacons at County Highway CB and County Highway JJ Proposed Roundabout.

- B. Cardoza stated that the Parks and Trails Committee is recommending approval of this resolution.
- G. Armstrong suggested that additional language be included to state that the County will manage continued maintenance costs of the flashing beacons.

**Motion:** J. Weiss / B. Cardoza to approve Resolution 2021-07 with additional language related to continued maintenance costs.

#### Proposed Signalization at Larsen Road and Neenah High School Drive

Update on Proposed Signalization at Larsen Road and the new Neenah High School Drive.

- E. Skerke updated the Board on the recent conversations about the potential signalization at Larsen Road, regardless of the Warrant Analysis and recommendation that signalization is warranted, Neenah Joint School District is not changing their original stance. The School District questioned the Village about a three way stop sign and why that was not considered.
- G. Armstrong stated a three-way stop sign might be a good compromise.
- R. Schmeichel is willing to have a conversation with Village President, Dale Youngquist and School Board President Brian Eply regarding this.

She further stated that her priority is the Town of Neenah and it would not require additional hours for the Deputy Clerk-Treasurer. There were no objections.


