Hello Keating Park Neighbors,

The Town of Neenah recently upgraded the facilities at Keating Park with a restroom and gazebo area to enhance this beautiful neighborhood park. We continue to work on improving our parks throughout the Town of Neenah and take great pride in the amenities offered to our residents and visitors. Please join members of the Parks and Trails Committee on Monday September 3, 2024 at 5:30pm for an informal Open House to celebrate the opening of the new facilities at Keating Park.

In 2023 and again in 2024, Keating Park experienced numerous incidents of vandalism which not only impact the enjoyment of the park for all, but are costly and time consuming to investigate and repair. We have reason to believe that some of the vandalism may be caused by youth that are within walking distance of Keating Park. The recent vandalism occurred on the night of Sunday July 14th and included pink and red spray paint on picnic tables, rocks, the parking lot, We Energies electric box and trees along the wooded walking trail. Additional spray paint vandalism also occurred at the Town Hall parking lot, it would seem to be the same style and approximately the same time frame.

As residents that live in the Keating Park neighborhood, and hopefully frequent users of the park area, we are asking that you get involved. Keep an eye on the park, if you see something unusual, speak up and contact the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department. (920) 727-2888. Speak with your pre-teen and teenage children about the impact of vandalism, it is disrespectful, costly and illegal.

The Parks Committee will be installing additional security cameras. We will prosecute and hold accountable all individuals involved in illegal activity in our parks as they are identified.

Please help us to keep our parks a clean, safe and friendly place to enjoy.
