- Stuart Boerst reported there are Rusty Patch Bumble Bees at Conservancy Park. The bees are on the endangered species list.
- Rails along entry and around test plot to be installed. J. Cowling estimated cost not to excel \$2,500.00.

b. Franzoi Park

- > Teeter totter has been repaired.
- Hydrangea trees starting to tip and fall, need stronger stakes to be put in.

- > Metal benches all painted and ready to go.

c. Keating Park

- Vandalism in the park spray paint it is mostly cleaned up, including spray painting on trees on the path.
