Presentation by Craig Moser, East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, proposal for 2025 services to update the Town of Neenah Comprehensive Plan and Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan.

- Craig Moser, East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission reviewed their proposal to complete a Comprehensive Plan Update and Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan Update
 - Gave a brief overview of East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission services, they cover a 10-county region.
 - Reviewed in proposal for the combined updates. The project will span over two years.
 - The proposal is a not to exceed value. ECWRPC bills for time and materials only, there is no
 profit margin built into the cost, it is actual expenses incurred by ECWRPC
 - The costs will be spread over two calendar years and can spread over two budgets.
- R. Schmeichel noted the current Comprehensive Plan was created in 2009, updated in 2014
- E. Skerke noted the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan was for 2016 2020.
- C. Moser will provide a breakout of expenses for 2025 and 2026 calendar years.
- C. Moser explained that part of the planning process includes public involvement, there is an
 opportunity to overlap that public involvement for both the Comprehensive Plan and the
 Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan
- General discussion of neighboring communities that ECWRPC is working with and potential to partner with neighboring communities for cost savings. C. Moser provided a sample Comp Plan from Town of Buchanan

Memo: 2024 Engine 39 - Final payment with delivery.

Fire Chief Osero anticipates final delivery of the new fire truck end of September 2024, perhaps first week of October 2024. This ahead of the original planned delivery in 2025.

Final payment will be required upon delivery. I do not yet have the final invoice however anticipate that the total amount will be below \$300,000. The next Town Board meeting is not until October 14, 2024; thus, I am asking for the Board to authorize payment in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.

Total Price per sales order dated September 2023:

\$804,696.04

Payment #1 September 2023:

\$315,000

Payment #2 March 2024:

\$200,000 (included in 2024 Budget)

Final Payment due per Sales Order:

\$289,696.04

The sales order amount of \$804,696.04, however there have been some change orders that could exceed the \$6,000 allowance included in the original sales order. Chief Osero is waiting for the final invoice for his review.

Chief Osero and I request that the Town Board consider making a motion at the September 23, 2024 town board meeting to pre-approve final payment for the Fire Truck in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.

This final payment was not anticipated until 2025 and is not included in the 2024 Budget. A Resolution for a Budget Amendment will be presented to the Town Board at the October 14, 2024 Town Board meeting.



Memo: Urban Forestry Grant - Resolution 2024-12

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The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources offers Urban Forestry Grants to local municipalities.

The grant program has three categories: Regular Grants, Startup Grants and Catastrophic Storm Grants.

- The Startup Grants can be awarded for up to three years.
- In 2023, the Town was awarded their first Start Up grant of \$5,000. (year 1)
- The Committee would like to apply for year 2 of the startup grant program for 2025 funding.
- The DNR requires a new resolution for each application year.
- The Town Board approved a similar Resolution in 2023, Resolution 2023-17.

The startup grant is a 50/50 reimbursement program with a cost range of \$1,000 - \$5,000. (Total project cost range \$2,000 - \$10,000).

Resolution 2024-12 would give the Parks and Trails Committee authorization to apply for a 2025 startup grant. The Resolution is tailored from a sample resolution provided by the DNR and with DNR's encouragement, it is a combined authorizing resolution. In the DNR's words "It allows the Authorized Representative to submit both Urban Forestry and/or Urban Forestry Catastrophic Storm grant applications. This is strongly recommended, so that, if a catastrophic storm event occurs and the Governor declares a State of Emergency in the applicant's county, then the applicant's Authorized Representative already has the authority to apply for an Urban Forestry Catastrophic Storm grant."

The Parks and Trails Committee's goal is to apply for the full grant amount of \$5,000 in 2025 and again in 2026 to complete the three-year startup cycle. Following the start up grant cycle, the Town would be eligible to apply in the regular grant program.

The Parks and Trails Committee is respectfully requesting that the Town Board support this initiative to improve the urban forestation in the Town Parks.

WINNEBAGO COUNTY HIGHWAY & TOWN OF NEENAH MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

Whereas, the Town of Neenah, a town located in Winnebago County, would like to retain the services of the Winnebago County Highway Department to provide and deliver certain highway-related maintenance work during the calendar year of 2025; and

Whereas, the Winnebago County Highway Department is willing and able to perform said maintenance services on behalf of the Town of Neenah during calendar year 2025.

Now, therefore, for that mutual consideration as stated herein, it is agreed by and between the Town of Neenah and the Winnebago County Highway Department as follows:

- 1. This agreement shall be for a period of one-year commencing the <u>1st day of January</u>, <u>2025 and continuing through December 31, 2025.</u>
- 2. Winnebago County agrees to provide maintenance for 27.34 miles of Town roadway located within said government territory. The General Transportation Aids (GTA) rate calculated by the Wisconsin DOT for payment to the Towns in 2025 is approximately \$2,845 per mile which yields a GTA payment for Neenah of approximately \$77,782.
- 3. This maintenance work shall include winter maintenance, general maintenance and miscellaneous work as needed during the year;

- 4. The Town shall pay for all maintenance work performed & delivered in accordance with the wage rates, material costs and machinery rental rates of the Winnebago County Highway Department as established by Winnebago County.
- 5. All work will be on a time and materials basis and will be at the direction of the Town.
- 6. In addition to the wage rates, material costs, and equipment rental rates it is agreed that the cost for salt shall be \$96.00 per ton.
- 7. Both parties agree not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, religion, color, handicap, sex, physical condition, developmental disability, sexual orientation as defined in s.51.01(5) Wis. Stats., or national origin. This provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, layoff or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship.
- 8. The Town of Neenah agrees at all times during the term of this agreement to; indemnify, save harmless, and defend Winnebago County, its Board, Officers, Employees, and Representatives may sustain, incur or be required to pay by reason Winnebago County, furnishing services, or goods required to be provided under this Agreement, provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to liabilities, losses, charges, costs, or expenses caused solely by or resulting from the acts or omissions of Winnebago County, its Agencies, Boards, Officers, Employees, or Representatives.

Memo: Cell Tower Lease

The current cell tower lease agreement that the Town holds was signed in September 2014, terms are 5 years with automatic renewal for Four (4) successive Five (5) year Renewal Lease Term(s). Annual rent started at \$15,000 with an annual 3% increase over the previous year's base rent on the anniversary of commencement. Any additional subleases will provide additional rental income of 15% of the sublease rent. Increase to this 15 % portion will be determined by the sublease agreement. There is one sublease on the tower.

The Town received offers from two companies to buy out our exiting lease. One of those buyout offers is from our current lessee. The Town also received a request from our current lessee to amend the current lease extending it an additional 25 years.

There are two agenda items for consideration of each of these items, The amendment to extend the lease terms and the buyout offers.
